VISITING THE SCHOOL

We invite you to visit AMPS on Wednesday, August 24th from 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. or Thursday, August 25th between 1:00 p.m.– 3:00 p.m. only. The nurse will be available to receive medication during those hours. Boxes will be left outside the classrooms for you to drop off supplies, if you wish.

IMPORTANT NEWS CONCERNING EMERGENCY CONTACT INFORMATION:

In preparation for the 2022-2023 school year, please find the following enclosed:

1. **Census Verification Report (Due back September 1, 2022):**
 - a. **Emergency Contact Card (enclosed blue card).** Please review this document carefully and make any changes directly on the report. Any additional information or specific instructions can be included on the back side of the card. Please indicate that you have discussed arrangements with your child in the event of an emergency dismissal.
 - b. Please sign the back of the card to indicate that you have read and understand the **Miller Place School District Computer Network Acceptable Use and Internet Safety Policy** (Board of Education Policy #4526) located above the signature line. This policy can be found on the District website (Board of Education/BOE Policies). **Please note that your child will not be permitted computer access without the aforementioned signatures.**
2. **Custodial Documentation Form:** If applicable, please fill out this form and return it with any necessary documentation in a sealed envelope to the main office.
3. **Bus Tag:** To help ensure that your child gets on the correct "Go Home" bus the first weeks of school, be sure to attach the enclosed tag to your child's backpack with the following information:
 - * YOUR CHILD'S NAME and THEIR TEACHER'S NAME
 - * THE "GO HOME" BUS ROUTE LETTER AND BUS STOP
 - * THE ADDRESS OF THE END OF DAY BUS STOP

ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

Cafeteria: Breakfast and lunch are available for purchase in our cafeteria. Please help your child learn their four digit PIN Code for the first day of school. We will of course help them if they don't remember.

Transportation: We encourage you to allow your children to ride the bus to and from school beginning the first day. You can find your child's bus information on the School Tool Parent Portal under "User Defined". Buses may run late for the first few days of school. Please do not be concerned. It is a normal part of the beginning of the school year. Transportation questions can be answered by calling, FIRST STUDENT Bus Company at (631) 924-8400.

Arrival and Dismissal: If you must drive your child to or from school, you will need to drive up to the upper playground parking lot and walk down the steps to the side door.

* Arrival drop off: 9:15 a.m. – 9:25 a.m.

* Dismissal pick up: 3:40 p.m. – 3:50 p.m.

If you are picking up your child, please send in a note with your child in the morning. Please make sure your note has the date, your child's first name, last name and the name of the person who will be picking up. Please try not to pick up your child between 3:30 p.m. and 3:40 p.m. as it interferes with a smooth dismissal procedure.

Every person picking up a student will be asked to show photo ID. If you do not have a proper ID on your person, you will be asked to retrieve it before you are allowed to pick up your child.

Allergy Alert Classrooms: If your child has been placed in an allergy alert classroom, please review the documents in this packet closely to be certain that you are aware of any allergies that classmates have. This may affect the snack that can be consumed during in-class snack time. Students will be allowed to bring any items they would like to eat for lunch. Please be advised that all classroom visitors will also need to strictly adhere to the allergy restrictions in all classrooms.
