Please allow this communication to update you regarding information recently sent to you by your child's Building Principal.

The name of your child's teacher will be available, via School Tool on Tuesday, September 1, 2020 after 4:00pm.

The dates for your children to walk through their school has been changed from Monday, August 31, 2020 to **Wednesday, September 2, 2020 and Thursday, September 3, 2020** between the hours of 8:30am and 12:00pm. At this time, parents and guardians will also be able to drop off medication to the School Nurse. Please note, this change in dates and times will allow your child to follow the path from the bus drop off location to their assigned classroom.

All students, parents and guardians must wear a mask or face covering for the duration of visiting Andrew Muller Primary School and Laddie A. Decker Sound Beach School. In addition, when possible, please maintain appropriate distance from other families as you walk the hallways of our schools.

Attached for your convenience, is the required Visitor Health Screening form that **needs to be completed for each student, parent and guardian** who are visiting our schools. Completing a form for you, and a separate form for your child, prior to arriving at their school will expedite your entry into the building.

Thank you for your anticipated cooperation and understanding as we continue to organize the many logistical variables of opening schools as safe as possible in September 2020.
