Re: 2019-20 Parent Paid Pre-K Program

Dear Parents, Guardians and Staff,

The Board of Education, Administrative Staff, and I are happy to share with you information regarding the upcoming 2019-20 initiative for a parent paid Pre-K Program.

Regarding the program:

- To qualify for the program, children must be four years old by December 1, 2019
- SCOPE will operate the program at Andrew Muller Primary School
- Registration will be done on-line, via www.scopeonline.us, at a future date
- The Pre-K Program will be 5 days per week and will follow the Miller Place School District school calendar
- The morning session times are 8:45 – 11:15 AM
- The afternoon session times are 12:30 – 3:00 PM
- Each class will be staffed with a certified teacher and teacher assistant
- Enrollment for each class cannot exceed 18 Pre-K students
- Parents must provide transportation to and from the program
- The District will not provide any transportation services for the Pre-K Program
- Meals are not part of the Pre-K Program, but SCOPE will provide appropriate snacks
- The parent cost for the Pre-K Program, paid directly to SCOPE, is \$270 per month

SCOPE representatives are inviting all interested parents to an information meeting scheduled for Monday, April 15, 2019 at 7:00PM, which will take place in the Andrew Muller Primary School café-gym-atorium.

We look forward to meeting with those interested in the parent paid Pre-K Program on April 15th. At that time, additional questions you may have regarding the program can be answered.
