Dear Parents/Guardians,

New York State law requires a health examination for all students **entering the school district for the first time and when entering Pre-K or K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade.**

The examination must be completed by a New York State licensed physician, physician assistant or nurse practitioner and be completed on the approved *NYSED Student Health Examination Form for School*

A dental certificate which states your child has been seen by a dentist or dental hygienist is also asked for at the same time. The school will provide you with a list of dentists and registered dental hygienists who offer dental services on a free or reduced cost basis if you ask for it.

- A copy of the health examination must be provided to the school within 30 days from when your child first starts at the school, and when your child starts K, 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, & 11<sup>th</sup> grades. If a copy is not given to the school within 30 days, the school will contact you.
- If your child has an appointment for an exam during this school year that is after the first 30 days of school, please notify the Health Office with the date.
- A copy of the NYS Health Examination Form can be downloaded on our Health Office tab on this website.

We suggest you make copies of the completed forms for your own records before sending them to the school health office.

# News from the Health Office

2020-2021 School Year

## NEW YORK STATE LAW MANDATES THAT:

All Incoming 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Students are required to have the booster immunization containing tetanus, diphtheria and acellular pertussis (Tdap) as well as 3-5 doses of polio and 2 varicella (chicken pox) vaccines. These immunizations are required prior to admission to the 6<sup>th</sup> grade.

7<sup>th</sup> grade students are MANDATED BY NEW YORK STATE LAW to have a Physical Exam. All students entering 7<sup>th</sup> grade must also provide proof of having received the meningococcal vaccine.

Regular checkups for dental hygiene and physical examinations are recommended for all students to aid in a healthy school year.

If your child needs medication during the school day, please have your physician fill out the Medication Authorization Form **AND** supply the proper medication. Please be sure the medication is in the properly labeled original container.

We are requesting that you return all medical and dental forms to the Health Office in September or you may mail them to the attention of the NCR Health Office.

If your child sustains an injury in or out of school, **please notify the Health Office** so that we can provide any assistance that your child may need. **All medical notes need to be submitted to the Health Office.** We will then distribute them to PE teachers and coaches as needed.

1. Parent and Physician Authorization for Medication in School
2. Physical Examination Form (Mandated for all 7<sup>th</sup> Graders)
3. Meningococcal Vaccine Form (Mandated for all 7<sup>th</sup> Graders)
4. 6<sup>th</sup> Grade Immunization Form (Immunizations Mandated for all 6<sup>th</sup> Graders)
5. Dental Hygiene Form
