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*Dear Miller Place Parent:*

Welcome to the Miller Place Food Service Program! The District participates in the National School Lunch and Breakfast Program which meets federal and state dietary guidelines. The District offers parents three payment options for their child's meals, snacks, and beverages using an online credit card, check, or cash. **As a reminder, the Federal free meals for all students program has ended.** The District will continue to take meal applications and use family income to qualify students for free, reduced-price, or paid meals.

The District uses the online service called [MySchoolBucks.com](http://MySchoolBucks.com) where parents may deposit money directly into your child's school meal account with a \$2.75 bank fee. The online service allows all parents to view current balance and purchase information for the past ninety days without a fee. You will need each child's student ID number to enroll if you did not enroll last year. You may set up an account on MySchoolBucks.com at any time. Please see the [My School Bucks Online Payment Information Instructions Flyer](#) posted on the food service website. Parent may also choose to deposit money directly using check or cash. Any student account balances at the end of each school year will automatically be moved over to the next school year.

Students will need their PIN number to make any purchases. **We highly recommend your child memorize their PIN number.** They should not share this PIN number with their friends. This pin number will stay with the student until they graduate. The food service staff can look up a student's name if a student does not remember their PIN number.

If your family has qualified for free or reduced meal prices in the past, you will need to submit a new [Free & Reduced Price School Meals Application](#) for your child **every year**. Once we receive and approve your application, this information will be noted in the system, and the meal will be processed just as it is for all other students without any special indication to other students.

**Nondiscrimination Statement:** This explains what to do if you believe you have been treated unfairly.
