Re: COVID-19 Update for MPSD

Dear Parents, Guardians and Staff,

The following is the latest information regarding the impact COVID-19 is having on our District.

The District continues to receive hourly and daily guidance and direction from experts at Suffolk County organizations and representatives, the Suffolk County Department of Health, the New York State Department of Health, State Education Department, the New York State Governor's Office, as well as the Center for Disease Control.

After School Child Care **is still in session** this afternoon at AMPS and LADSBS.

Athletics – This message was sent to the Suffolk County athletic community by Section XI this morning: “As the coronavirus progresses, in an effort to be prudent, Section XI will suspend all games and scrimmages until April 3rd. As that date approaches, we will reassess the situation utilizing updated information. Each individual district can still make their own decision if they wish to conduct practices, however, Section will not be allowing any games, scrimmages or combined practices to take place until after April 3rd.”

Miller Place athletics will suspend all practices (JV and Varsity) effective immediately and through the weekend.

SAT – After working closely with the College Board, we have been able to reschedule tomorrow's exam for **Saturday, March 28, 2020** for those students who were already registered for our testing site. Our District will forward additional information to these students at a later date, as well as posting information on the District website.

LADSBS Science Fair – Tonight's fair has been cancelled for the public, but judging will continue by staff during the school day to evaluate student accomplishments.

All Building Use and District Events – All events are cancelled beginning at 4:00pm this afternoon for the upcoming weekend. This includes indoor and outdoor building use.

We continue to balance the ability to maintain some semblance of normalcy while protecting the health and safety of our students and staff during this difficult time. The District will continue to keep you updated as this situation continues to unfold.
