A message from MILLER PLACE HIGH SCHOOL

Good afternoon this is Mr. Slavin, Principal of the High School calling to inform parents of this afternoon's evacuation of students.

Today at approximately 12:50 pm the fire alarms were set off in the high school. This was caused by an electrical issue in one of the electrical closets. Once we were able to determine where the problem was located, students were evacuated to designated areas.

Traffic was stopped as part of our emergency response procedures until the building could be evaluated by the fire department. Once the building was deemed as safe, students and faculty returned to gather their belongings and be dismissed to the busses.

All afterschool and evening activities at the High School have been cancelled as a precaution and to allow us time to complete the repair.

I do want to commend students, faculty, staff, and parents for their patience and understanding as we enacted our emergency procedures.
