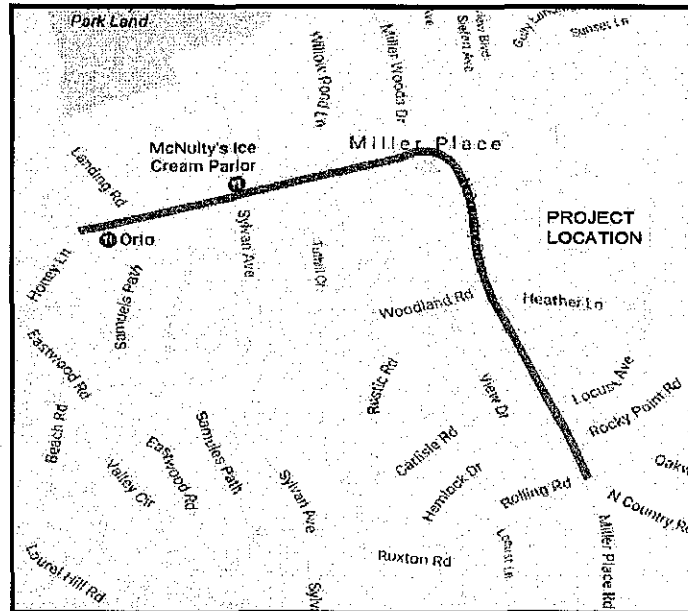

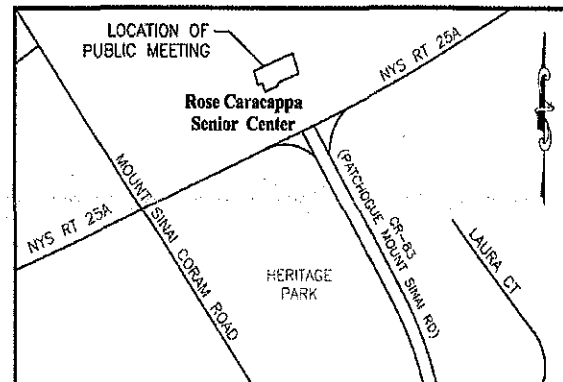

PURPOSE OF THE PUBLIC INFORMATION MEETING

The Brookhaven Highway Department, Traffic Safety Division will hold a public information meeting on Wednesday June 21, 2017 for the North Country Road Complete Streets and Transportation Alternatives Project, located in the Hamlet of Miller Place in the Town of Brookhaven.

The purpose of this meeting is to provide interested parties with an opportunity to examine the proposed design concept and offer comments to be considered by the Town of Brookhaven in developing the design of the project.

The public meeting will include exhibits presenting the proposed improvements. Brookhaven Highway Department, Traffic Safety Division representatives familiar with the design will be available to answer questions related to the project proposals.

Oral comments may be presented to Town representatives on an individual basis between 6:00 PM and 8:00 PM. Written comments may be submitted at the meeting or submitted by mail on forms that will be provided.

The Brookhaven Highway Department, Traffic Safety Division thanks you for your participation and input in the roadway design process. All information and comments received as part of this Public Information Meeting will be considered in developing a design that is most beneficial to local residents, businesses, and the traveling public.

PROJECT SUMMARY

This project has been initiated from a Federally funded Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) grant that has been implemented & awarded by the New York State Department of Transportation. The project specifically addresses issues related to pedestrian and motorist safety and mobility. Project limits along North Country Road are from Honey Lane to Rolling Road, a distance of 1.1 miles. The key objective of the project is to improve safety and mobility for pedestrians, bicyclists and motorists and to facilitate walking and bicycling as alternative transportation modes to motor vehicles.

Motorists:

- Decrease travel lane widths, install parallel parking, install left turning lane at the Intersection of North Country Road and Honey Lane, and install two raised median islands within project limits to generate traffic calming with designated on-street parking.
- Resurface North Country Road between Honey lane and the entrance to Laddie A. Decker Sound Beach School.

Pedestrians:

- Install A.D.A (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant sidewalk along North Country Road between Honey Lane and entrance to Laddie A. Decker Sound Beach School. This will provide a safe, continuous route for pedestrians traveling along the corridor.
- Existing crosswalks will be reconstructed with colored imprinted concrete and be equipped with push-button activated rapid flashing beacons.

These improvements supplement additional traffic calming and roadway improvements, which consists of the installation of a bike lane in each direction and drainage modifications. Improvements are expected to be under construction in the Spring of 2018.
