Re: Delayed Opening Monday, February 8, 2021

Good Evening Miller Place School District Community:

This communication contains important messages regarding the school schedule for tomorrow, Monday, February 8, 2021.

Due to the concerns regarding the current snow fall, and that roads may turn icy overnight, and/or not be sufficiently plowed, there will be a **two-hour delay opening** for all schools tomorrow with **students learning from in-school instruction** (not remote learning).

AMPS and LADSBS buses will be delayed for two hours – just as we have in the past.

All K-6 virtual classes (those who have been learning from home all year) will be delayed two-hours.

NCRMS and MPHS cohort 1 buses will be delayed for two hours – just as we have in the past.
NCRMS and MPHS cohort 2 will sign on to their Google classrooms at 9:07am and learn from home as they have all year.

There will be no before school activities, including clubs, music, and childcare, in any of our schools.

The two-hour delay transportation schedule will also be in effect for students attending full day BOCES programs, private schools, and out of district student placements.

The District will reevaluate the road conditions in the morning **by 5:30am**. If they are deemed **not safe** for school bus transportation, I will send you another message regarding the plan for our instructional day. If you do not receive a message from me we will adhere to the schedule noted above.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we continue to battle Mother Nature and so much more.
